## Nominations for Executive committee members

### CALL FOR NOMINATION TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBERS

In Eindhoven Executive Committee member's positions will be open for election at the General Assembly on 23<sup>rd</sup> of October.

The terms of the Executive Committee members; Mrs. Stella Diblik and Mrs. Irene Lee, are due to expire in the coming GA in Eindhoven.

Dr. John Nel is in the Executive Committee (instead of Eric Vandenabeele) until Eindhoven General Assembly. The rest of the term (of Vandenabeele) is in election. Retiring Executive Committee members are eligible for re-election.

Nominations are open to all FISAF members who may wish to put forward their representative for election to the Executive Committee Member. On the next page are the relevant clauses from the constitution regarding the election of Executive Committee members:

### Executive committee

The Executive Committee must:

- Consist of 5 representatives of members with no member having more than one representative at any one time;
- be elected by the Annual General Meeting for a term of 4 years from the date of election until the fourth Annual General Meeting following that election;
- consist of a President and 4 ordinary members; and nominate 3 of the ordinary members as delegates to represent three geographical regions of the world.

### Election of Members of the Executive Committee

The ballot for the election of all members of the Executive Committee must be conducted at the Annual General Meeting in such usual and proper manner as the Executive Committee may direct.

### Procedure

Candidates for positions on the Executive Committee must be nominated by their member organisation.

The nomination must be received by the Secretary General at [fisaf@fisaf.org](mailto:fisaf@fisaf.org) at least 15 days (latest 8<sup>th</sup> October) before the General Assembly.

Nominations must be accompanied by a written undertaking that in the event of the candidate being elected, the member will be responsible for the costs associated with attendance at meetings and the responsibilities of fulfilling that office.
